## WARNING:

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## DIRECTIONS

1. Use 3 oz. disinfectant to a gallon of lukewarm water.
2. Prepare solution by pouring disinfectant into pail first, then add water and stir well. Do not use boiling water.
3. Heavy soil deposits should be removed before applying any disinfecting solution.
4. Solution can be applied by mop or wash cloth; wet areas thoroughly.
5. If hands are sensitive to solution, rinse copiously with warm water and soap.
