The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five (5) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

Based on the pH of the product, the toxicity category should be I for local irritation (eye and skin). Change the signal word to "Danger" and add the following statements to the precautionary section:

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation.  
Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful  
if swallowed. Wear safety glasses or goggles and  
rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly after  
handling.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To sanitize equipment, walls and floors in food plants, institutions, motels, schools hospitals and public places.

1. Remove gross food particles and soil by a pre-flush, or pre-scrape and when necessary, a pre-soak treatment.
2. Thoroughly clean surfaces or objects by applying detergent or compatible cleaner followed by a potable water rinse before applying the sanitizing solution.
3. Apply proper use-solution onto surface, using spray, brush, or dip method.
