ACTIVE INGREDIENT:

Alkyl (C₁₄-95%, C₁₂-3%, C₁₆-2%) dimethyl
benzyl ammonium chloride dihydrate 5.0%
INERT INGREDIENTS (includes softeners) 95.0%

USE DIRECTIONS: To Soften Fabrics: Use 1½ oz. per 20 gal. water or 100 lbs. laundry. Add to final rinse or to sour rinse.
To Soften & Impart Bacteriostatic Activity to Fabrics : Use 3 oz. per 20 gal. water or 100 lbs. laundry. Add to final rinse or to sour rinse.

DANGER:

KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.

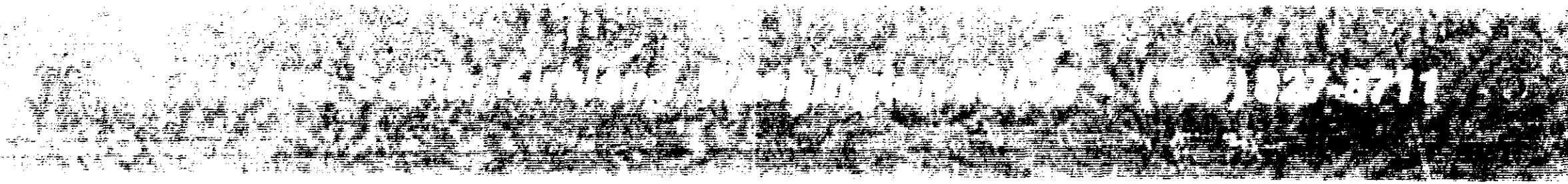
Causes eye damage and severe skin irritation. Corrosive. Do not get in eyes, or skin, or on clothing. Harmful or fatal, if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid breathing dust. Protect eyes and skin when handling concentrate. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush skin or eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 min. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, give promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, give large amounts of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
