For eyes, flush with water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention. When handling, wear gloves and goggles or a face shield. While making solutions, add slowly to surface of water to avoid spattering. Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. Do not take internally.

FIRST AID: External - Flood skin with water, then wash with vinegar. For eyes, wash with water and then with 5% boric acid solution. Internal - Give citrus juices or vinegar copiously and follow with olive oil. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. Rinse empty container with water and discard it.

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Areas or articles must be cleaned before sanitizing. Clean area or article by applying cleaner-sanitizer solution using brush or high pressure applicator.
- 2. Apply sanitizing solution and allow cleaner-sanitizer to remain on equipment for minimum 10 minutes contact time for maximum sanitizing benefit.
- 3. Rinse with clean water.
