Best-Yet!

Best-Yet! is a concentrated cleaner and limited disinfectant for killing odor causing bacteria in those areas where bad odors can be a problem. Best-Yet! is recommended for household and industrial use and is effective for cleaning and deodorizing toilet areas, shower stalls, garbage receptacles, garbage disposals, and similar areas.

DIRECTIONS

CLEANING: Mix 2 ounces with each gallon of water. Use this solution to clean floors, walls, woodwork, or other hard surfaces. Rinse is not required, except on asphalt tile. Use full strength to make quick work of extra heavy grease and grime.

DISINFECTS AGAINST ODOR CAUSING BACTERIA: Use a solution of 2 ounces to each gallon water for deodorizing garbage and trash containers, toilet areas, shower stalls, and other hard surfaces where odors can be a problem. Kills odor causing bacteria. Clean excess dirt first. Apply solution to surfaces and let stand for at least 10 minutes, then remove excess. Rinsing is not necessary.

LAUNDRY: Best-Yet! is particularly effective on grease stains. Apply full strength to grease spots and other stains. Rub in before loading into washer. Add 1 ounce along with your regular soap or detergent for extra cleaning and deodorizing action during the wash.

KILLS FLEAS, LICE, AND TICKS FOR DOGS AND CATS

When used as directed, Best-Yet! kills fleas and lice in minutes and ticks overnight.

FOR FLEAS AND LICE: Mix 1 ounce Best-Yet! into each gallon of bath water. Thoroughly wet the animals coat with this solution, taking care to saturate hidden areas such as the underside and the area between legs. Allow the coat to remain wet for at least five minutes. The animal may then be dried, but no fresh-water rinse is necessary. When treating long-haired animals, it may be helpful to bathe it first with soap and water. Rinse out the soap, and then use the Best-Yet! solution as a final bath.

FOR TICKS: Use as directed for fleas and lice except use a solution of 3 ounces Best-Yet! for each gallon of bath water.

PREMISE SPRAY: Use a solution of 3 ounces Best-Yet! in 1 gallon water and spray or sprinkle solution in kennels or other places infested with fleas.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS: May cause eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with food.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DISPOSAL: securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
