**SPIDERS, SILVER FISH, BROWN DOG TICKS, CARPET BEETLES:** Paint or spray KIL-KWIK on localized infested areas of baseboards; and floors. Spray into crevices around walls and corners. Spot treat along edges of rugs and underneath rugs . . . furniture. Use in basement, around ledges, corners, windows, doors, crevices & drains.

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid prolonged breathing of spray mist. Avoid prolonged and repeated contact with skin; wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of food and feed products. Keep out of reach of children. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.
