DIRECTIONS

Flying Insects for control of flies, mosquitoes, gnats, boxelder bugs, wasps, and hornets, direct the spray towards the upper portion of the room and saturate the atmosphere with the mist using 2 to 3 ounces to each 1,000 cubic feet of space.

DIRECTIONS

For effective results against the active stages of flying insects, use a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist. Treat infested areas thoroughly and whenever possible, keep doors and windows closed for 10 minutes after spraying. **Caution:** Do not spray when rooms are occupied.

For the control of roaches, ants, fleas, crickets, ticks, waterbugs, silverfish, clover mites and spiders. Thorough and repeated spraying of the infested area is necessary, working the spray into cracks and other hiding places. Spray directly on insects with repeated applications.

For the control of ants: Spray thoroughly all ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where the pests enter the premises. Repeated applications are required in all cases.

For the control of fleas and ticks spray repeatedly on floors, baseboards, floor coverings, and wall cracks, as well as sleeping quarters of animals.

For control of bedbugs, thorough and repeated spraying of the bed and mattress is necessary, also the spray should be directed into all cracks and hiding places about the bedroom, around baseboards, walls, and floors.

Remove or cover fish bowls or aquaria from areas to be treated.
