GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or material that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes, but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to prevent or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high-level disinfection.

Sanitizing of Food Processing Equipment and Other Hard Surfaces in Food Contact Locations. For sanitizing food processing equipment, dairy equipment, food utensils, dishes, silverware, glasses, sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other hard nonporous surfaces. No Potable water rinse is required.

Wash and rinse all articles thoroughly, then apply a solution of 1 oz. of this product in 4 gallons of water (150 ppm active). Surfaces should remain wet for at least one minute. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. For mechanical application, use solution may not be reused for sanitizing applications.

Apply to sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other stationary hard surfaces by cloth or brush or mechanical spray device. No Potable water rinse is required.

Dishes, silverware, glasses, cooling utensils and other similar ware food processing equipment can be sanitized by immersion in a 1 oz./4 gallon solution of this product. No Potable water rinse is required.

At 1 oz./4 gallons, this product fulfills the criteria of Appendix F of the Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1978 Recommendations of the U.S. Public Health services in waters up to 800 ppm of hardness calculated as $CaCO_3$, when evaluated by the ADAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizer Method against *Escherichia coli* and *Staphylococcus aureus*.

The udders, flanks and teats of dairy cows can be sanitized by washing with a solution of 1 oz. of the product in 4 gallons of warm water. No Potable water rinse is required. Use a fresh towel for each cow. Avoid contamination of sanitizing solution by dirt and soil. Do not dip used towel back into sanitizing solution. When solution becomes visibly dirty, discard and provide fresh solution.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.
