# MORTON SPACE SPRAY

FOR THE CONTROL OF FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS,  
GNATS AND OTHER SMALL FLYING INSECTS,  
In a Single Service Disposable Pressure Container.

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:**

Pyrethrins ----- 0.5%  
Technical Piperonyl Butoxide\* - 4.0%  
Petroleum Distillates ----- 5.5%

**INERT INGREDIENTS** ----- 90.0%  
Total Ingredients ----- 100.0%

\* Equivalent to 3.2% (Butylcarbityl) (6-Propyl-  
piperonyl) ether and 0.8% other related compounds.

**DIRECTIONS:**

Remove cap, hold container in upright position, point valve in desired direction and press dispensing button to spray. Hold at least 3 feet from all objects to avoid staining. Close room before spraying, leave closed and unoccupied for at least 30 minutes after treatment. Sweep up and destroy all fallen insects.

**RESTAURANTS, HOMES, FOOD PACKAGING AND FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS,  
DAIRY PROCESSING PLANTS**

For control of flies, mosquitoes, gnats, flying moths, and other flying insects as specified: apply at rate of 4 to 5 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Direct aerosol toward all parts of room and especially windows or light sources which attract these insects. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Repeat as necessary.

**WARNING:** Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not store at a temperature in excess of 120° F. Do not spray while plant is in operation. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not spray in or toward face or eyes. Avoid prolonged inhalation of vapors. Do not spray near or toward open flame. Do not spray on skin of animals. In case of skin contact, wash with soap and water. Remove any cold blooded animals, birds, pets and fish from the area being treated.
