

### GENERAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING

Use 1/2 cup of disinfectant per gallon of water for general cleaning and disinfecting of washable surfaces. For heavy soiling, use 1 cup per gallon. For deodorizing, use 1/4 cup per gallon.

### CLEANING TOILETS AND URINALS

Use 1/2 cup of disinfectant per gallon of water for cleaning and disinfecting of toilets and urinals. For heavy soiling, use 1 cup per gallon. For deodorizing, use 1/4 cup per gallon.

### FOR HOSPITAL USE

Use 1/2 cup of disinfectant per gallon of water for general cleaning and disinfecting of hospital surfaces. For heavy soiling, use 1 cup per gallon. For deodorizing, use 1/4 cup per gallon.

### FOR WASHABLE PAINTED SURFACES

Cabinets, screens, doors, lawn and porch furniture, painted surfaces, sinks, stoves, refrigerators, bathtubs, washbasins, garbage and trash cans. Remove the gross dirt and soil before applying disinfectant. Then use 3 to 4 tablespoons disinfectant for each quart of hot water and wash surface thoroughly. Then wipe surface, rinse with potable water.

### DEODORIZATION

Use disinfectant on surfaces during heavy soiling with a solution containing 1/2 cup per gallon of water. For general deodorizing, use 1/4 cup per gallon. For heavy soiling, use 1 cup per gallon. For deodorizing, use 1/4 cup per gallon. When used as directed, it will disinfect surfaces such as floors, walls, counter tops. It may be relied upon to deodorize areas, garbage pits, food storage areas and other areas where odors develop. It may be used as a general antibacterial detergent in schools, hospitals, nursing homes, food processing plants and in the home for general cleaning and disinfection. See left panel for use directions.

### DANGER:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, nose, or clothing. Wash hands when handling. Handle with care to avoid contamination of food.

### FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. Remove contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. If available, drink large quantities of milk. Call a physician immediately.

### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Possible mucosal damage may cause use of gastric lavage. Measure age, shock, respiratory depression, and other signs.

#### GENERAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING:

Dilute 1 part of disinfectant with 80 parts (1 oz. to approx. 2 1/2 quarts) of lukewarm water. Guardall can be added to any soap or detergent solution to improve disinfecting qualities. Excellent for removing odors, dirt and grease from floors, wood work, sinks, basements.

#### CLEANING TOILETS AND URINALS:

Expel the residual bowl water over the trap with a bowl mop or plunger prior to the application of the use solution. Use a solution of 1/2 pint to 5 gallons of water. Wash thoroughly and then pour solution down drain to aid deodorizing.

#### FOR HOSPITAL USE:

To disinfect pseudomonas aeruginosa use 10 oz. or approximately 1/4 pint of disinfectant per one gallon of water.

#### FOR WASHABLE PAINTED SURFACES:

Cabinets, screens, doors, lawn and porch furniture, porcelain surfaces, sinks, stoves, refrigerators, bath tubs, washbasins, garbage and trash cans, remove the gross dirt and soil before applying disinfectant, then use 3 to 4 tablespoons disinfectant for each quart of hot water and wash surface thoroughly, then wipe surface, rinse with potable water.

## DEODORIZATION:

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning mop or brush surfaces with a solution containing 6 ounces of disinfectant per gallon of water. This is an effective anti-bacterial cleaner designed for use in household, industrial and institutional cleaning. When used as directed it will disinfect hard surfaces such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage pails, food storage areas, etc. in areas and other areas where odor and stains may develop. It may be used as a general purpose antibacterial detergent in schools, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, etc. Do not use on food processing plants and in other places where a high level of cleaning and disinfection is required. See left panel for use directions.

## DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Causes irritation. Do not get in eyes or on skin. If swallowed, avoid.

## FIRST AID:

If in eyes, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

## NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
