The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

A. Delete the site "Commercial Establishments." This site is too broad.

B. Delete the surface "toilets." Your label does not include directions for use in toilet bowls. In addition, if this product is intended to be applied to the inside of the toilet bowl without removal of the toilet bowl water, you would be required to submit data to show that your product is efficacious when diluted into the volume of water present in a toilet bowl.

C. In the directions "For Disinfecting" revise to include the statement: "Then wipe up excess product or allow to air dry." immediately following the statement: "Spray until surface is thoroughly wet and will remain so for 10 minutes." In addition, revise the last statement of this section to state "All food contact surfaces *including counter tops, stoves, interiors of refrigerators, and ranges* must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water after the 10 minute contact time."

D. In the "Storage and Disposal" section revise the subheading "Storage" to state "Pesticide Storage." In addition, the final statements of this section "[1 gallon or less]: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and discard in trash." must begin with the subheading "Storage and Disposal" not "Container Disposal."

E. You have identified the site "manufacturing plants" on your label. If it is your intention to market this product for use in food processing plants then you must submit an amendment to include specific use directions for food processing plants. You must list specific non-food contact sites and surfaces for disinfection. You will also need to add the disclaimer statement: "Do not use on food contact/processing surfaces." or state "Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. After use all surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water."

2. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

This product will remove grease, oil, soot and most kinds of ordinary dirt from surfaces. Effective on walls, floors, garbage cans, diaper pails, bed frames, counter tops, tubs, toilets, sinks, shower curtains, benches, lockers, desks, chairs, stoves, refrigerators and ranges that are made of the following washable, hard, non-porous environmental surfaces: metal, wood that has been sealed, plastic, concrete, glass, vinyl, glazed tile, glazed porcelain, stainless steel, linoleum and painted surfaces. Do not use this product to clean the following food contact surfaces: utensils, glassware and dishes.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to preclean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

For General Cleaning: Spray directly on surface. Wipe off with cloth or sponge.

For Disinfecting: Thoroughly clean surfaces prior to the application of this product. After surface is cleaned, hold can upright 6" to 8" from surface to be treated. Spray until surface is thoroughly wet and will remain so for 10 minutes. All food contact surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water after the 10-minute contact time.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in tightly closed original container in a secure area inaccessible to children. **Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **Container Disposal:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. **Container Disposal [1 gallon or less]:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
