 - 2. Delete" leather" as a use site for it is not a hard non-porous surface.

- 3. Since there is a restroom claim on your label, you must add the following toilet bowl directions to your label:
 - " Add 5oz. to the toilet bowl and mix. Thoroughly brush over exposed surfaces and under the rim. Allow to stand for 10 minutes and flush.
- 4. Correct the nomenclature for the following microorganisms to read:

Salmonella choleraesuis, Candida albicans, Enterobacter aerogenes, and Shigella sonnei.

5. Add the following Storage and Disposal statements for containers larger than 1 gallon.

Do not contaminate water, food, feed by storage or disposal.
