The presence of algae in swimming pools is objectionable because of the odor, cloudiness, color, and increased chlorine demand of the water. POOL-CARE ALGAECIDE is an extremely efficient means of keeping the water in swimming pools clear and free of visible algae.

#### DANGER

#### DIRECTIONS

1. In freshly-filled pools or pools showing no visible algae growth, add one gallon POOL-CARE ALGAECIDE per 25,000 gallons of water to prevent algae growth.
2. If algae growth is observed, add one gallon POOL-CARE ALGAECIDE for each 10,000 gallons of water to kill and control those algae species most commonly found in swimming pools. When existing growth is dead, clean the pool, drain and refill if necessary, and add one gallon POOL-CARE ALGAECIDE per 25,000 gallons of water.
3. Maintenance does for pool water treated as in (1) or (2) above: Add one gallon of POOL-CARE ALGAECIDE per 50,000 gallons of water every five to seven days.
