Directions: Do not mix with soap or synthetic detergents. Articles to be disinfected should first be washed and rinsed.

General disinfection in hospitals, public rooms and at home. Apply solution containing one ounce of Safto per 2 gallons of water freely to surfaces.

Disinfection against Athlete's Foot Organisms. Apply solution containing one ounce of Safto per 2 gallons of water to locker room and pool-side floors.

Sanitization of glassware, silverware, dishes, cooking utensils, etc.: Clean with a suitable detergent, rinse thoroughly, then dip in a sanitizing rinse made with 1 ounce of Safto in 4 (or 5) gallons of water, and air dry. DO NOT USE A TOWEL. (Recommended dilution should conform with local Health Department regulations.) Rinse with potable water.

Sanitization of dairy equipment: Clean and rinse thoroughly. Then immerse in sanitizing solution diluted 1 ounce of Safto per 4 gallons of water. Milk cans and other equipment should be air dried. The same dilution is also recommended for flank and udder washing prior to milking. Rinse with potable water.

Sanitization of equipment in food processing plants, including meat plants: Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly. Then, scrub with a solution of 1 ounce Safto per 4 gallons of water. Flush equipment with a clear water rinse before re-use. On surfaces difficult to clean completely (such as meat cutting boards) increase strength of sanitizing solution to 1 ounce to 1 gallon of water, then rinse with potable water.
