Beestroy Directions

Preferably on a cold day when bees are confined squirt Beestroy into the opening where bees enter the outside wall using a thumb pump type oil can. Shake well before pouring from can.

Listen for hum of bees by holding one ear tight against inner wall. Tiny holes (7/32) can be safely drilled to the bee nest, through the inside wall and Beestroy squirted through them. In cool weather place can in warm water a while before using.

Beestroy cannot do its job unless applied in the right place. You may have more than one colony. Within a few days, seal all outside openings where bees can enter.

Remove honey if in the ceiling to prevent leaking through. It seldom causes trouble in a side wall.

Warning:

Do not eat honey from destroyed colony.

Do not expose contaminated honey within reach of other bees, pets or children.
