The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Remove water from the ingredient statement or list all inert ingredients present in your product.
2. The words "ACTIVE INGREDIENTS" must be in singular.
3. In the Directions for Use change "(Provides at least 700 ppm Methyl Benzyl Ammonium Chloride)" to "(Provides at least 700 ppm active quaternary compound)."
4. The signal word "DANGER" and the Child Hazard Warning statement must immediately follow the ingredient statement on the front panel.
5. The Child Hazard Warning statement must be placed directly above the signal word "DANGER."

6. The ingredient statement must immediately follow the product name on the label. Refer to the enclosure "The Label" for appropriate type size requirements and proper formatting.
7. Indicate the method of application (e.g., "by sponge, mop, or spray" or "by immersion in the solution").
8. Indicate the contact time for effectiveness.
9. Indicate the major area (e.g., kennels, poultry processing houses, barns).
10. Please indicate if the product can be used on all types of boots (i.e., leathers, vinyl, or other plastics).
11. Refer to the DIS/TSS-15 enclosure for items 7 through 9.


Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

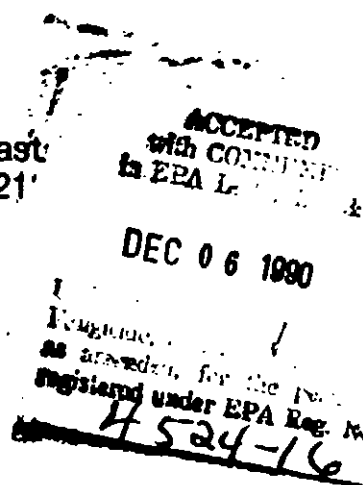

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
