DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use the product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

DILUTION DIRECTIONS: Dilute Monarch 400 Sanitizer at 1 ounce to 5 gallons of water (provides at least 200 ppm dodecylbenzene sulfonic acid). When used at levels less than 400 ppm dodecylbenzene sulfonic acid Monarch 400 Sanitizer does not require a potable water rinse in accordance with 21CFR 178.1010.

Monarch 400 Sanitizer does not lose effectiveness in hard water.

MONARCH 400 SANITIZER FOR DAIRY INDUSTRY AND FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS: For sanitizing stainless steel, glass, and other food contact surfaces used in pipelines, fittings, pumps, freezers, vats, silos, tanks, closed systems and food processing equipment. Remove gross food particles and soil by flushing, scraping or brushing. Pre-clean all surfaces with a chlorinated-alkaline cleaner. Rinse with potable water prior to application of sanitizing solution. Apply sanitizer by flooding, spraying or immersing equipment. For closed system sanitizing, fill pipeline with sanitizing solution. Thoroughly wet all surfaces. Contact time of at least 1 minute required followed by adequate draining. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. For mechanized applications, do not recirculate solution.

Monarch 400 Sanitizer is authorized by the USDA for use in Federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

APPLICATION

Recommended as a sanitizing rinse for pre-cleaned glassware and utensils in bars, restaurants, hotels and hospitals.

PREPARATION

Remove gross soils by flushing with water, scraping or brushing. Wash all surfaces. Rinse thoroughly with potable water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (GLASSES, DISHES OR UTENSILS)

To sanitize previously cleaned glassware and utensils, dip in a solution of 1 ounce sanitizer to 5 gallons of water. Provides 200 ppm dodecylbenzene sulfonic acid. Allow at least 2 minutes contact time. Remove and allow to air dry. Potable water rinse not required (21 CFR 178.1010).

Fresh solutions should be prepared daily or when solution appears dirty. This product is effective in hard water.
