The additional use label with the brand name SONAR, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable, provided you comply with the following conditions:

1. Make the following label changes on the finished printed label:
 - a. Change the brand name "Marase" to "Sonar."
 - b. The misuse statement, "It is a violation..." should follow the heading "Direction for Use."
 - c. Label directions must indicate that a fresh sanitizing solution is to be prepared daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled.
 - d. Delete the wording "industrial strength"; this claim is not acceptable. The label may claim to be a cleaner/sanitizer for table, bar, counter, and stainless steel surfaces in industrial use areas. However, such a claim would negate the recommendation of this product for sanitization in hospital kitchen and food preparation areas.
 - e. Delete the last paragraph on the left hand panel because it detracts from the labeling statements required under the Act and is not acceptable.
 - f. The last line on the center panel could read "For COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL, and HOSPITAL USE ONLY."


