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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THE PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

I-BAC is a concentrated product and must be diluted before using. Recommended for use on pre-cleaned, hard non-porous, environmental surfaces of food processing, milk manufacturing and dairy farms.

PREPARATION: Remove gross soils by flushing with water, scraping or brushing. Pre-clean all surfaces. Rinse thoroughly with potable water.

SANITIZING HARD NON-POROUS SURFACES: Equip. or stainless steels, pipelines, sags, processing vats, bulk tanks and utensils: To sanitize previously cleaned equipment and utensils dip, brush or spray equipment with a solution of I-BAC at 1 ounce to 5 gallons of water. Provides 25 ppm titratable iodine. Allow at least 2 minutes contact time. Allow equipment to drain well. Blow or air dry. When used at level's not exceeding 25 ppm titratable iodine, I-BAC does not require a potable water rinse in accordance with the CFR Part 178.1010. Fresh solutions should be prepared daily or when solution appears dirty. For mechanical applications, used sanitizing solutions may not be reused for sanitizing applications.

FOR HAND SANITIZING DIP:

1. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water.
2. Rinse hands thoroughly.
3. Dip hands in a solution containing I-BAC at the rate of 1/2 ounce per 5 gallons of water. This solution provides 12 1/2 ppm titratable iodine.

EGG SANITIZING: Eggs must first be washed with an approved cleaning compound, followed by a potable water rinse. **EGGS FOR BREAKING:** Washed and rinsed eggs shall be spray rinsed, not immersed with a concentration of not less than 12 ppm or not more than 25 ppm titratable iodine. **EGGS FOR PACKING:** Washed and rinsed eggs shall be spray rinsed, not immersed, with a concentration of not less than 12 ppm or not more than 25 ppm titratable iodine.

UDDER WASHING: Approximately one minute before applying milking unit, wash and massage teats with a clean paper towel wetted with a solution of I-BAC at 1/2 ounce to 2 1/2 gallons of water at 110°F. Provides 25 ppm titratable iodine.

Never reuse towels or dip a used towel back into solution. Always use freshly prepared solutions and non-corrosible utensils.

Mix only with water. Do not mix with products or solutions containing alkalis.
