DIRECTIONS:

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING. **Bac'cide** is a concentrated product and must be diluted before using. Recommended for use on pre-cleaned, hard non-porous surfaces in food processing, milk manufacturing and dairy farms.

PREPARATION: Remove gross soils by flushing with water, scraping or brushing. Pre-clean all surfaces. Rinse thoroughly with potable water. When used at levels not exceeding 25 ppm titratable iodine, **Bac'cide** is recommended for sanitizing food contact surfaces and equipment in beverage, meat and poultry, dairy and other food processing operations; glass or stainless filters, pipelines, silos, processing vats, milk tanks and utensils. To sanitize previously cleaned equipment, use a solution of **Bac'cide**.

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STORAGE & DISPOSAL:
