No-Rinse Acid Cleaner Sanitizer For Dairy, Food Processing and Farm Use—Removes Milkstone

DIRECTIONS:

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.
PHOS-ENQUAT is an acid cleaner/sanitizer for use on food processing and dairy equipment in water up to 800 ppm hardness (as CaCO₃). Do not rinse with water. For heavily soiled equipment, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily when used solution becomes visibly dirty. For mechanical application, used solution may not be reused for sanitizing applications.
Cleaning Bulk Milk Tanks, Dairy and Food Processing Equipment: Sanitizing: To sanitize hard non-porous food contact surfaces, such as milk tanks and milking equipment, clean with a good detergent and rinse thoroughly. Dilute 1 oz. of PHOS-ENQUAT in 4 gallons of water (150 ppm active quaternary) and apply with a cloth, brush, mechanical spray device (spray surface until

thoroughly wetted) or by immersion. Treated surfaces should remain wet for at least 60 seconds followed by adequate draining and air drying. Do not rinse with water.
Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance: At 1 oz./4 gallons PHOS-ENQUAT fulfills the criteria of Appendix I of the Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinances 1978 Recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Services in waters up to 800 ppm of hardness calculated as CaCO₃ when evaluated by the AIAAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizer Method against *Escherichia coli* and *Staphylococcus aureus*.
Udder Washing: Approximately one minute before applying milking unit, wash and massage teats with a clean paper towel wetted with a solution of PHOS-ENQUAT at 1 oz. to 4 gallons of water at 110°F. Provides 150 ppm solution. Never reuse towels or dip a used towel back into solution. Always use freshly prepared solutions and non-corrodible utensils.

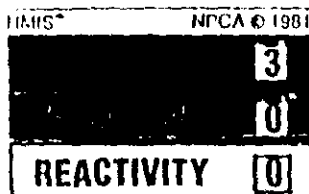
