On behalf of Rhodia, Inc., I am submitting a notification per PR Notice 98-10 for the product "Sodium Hypochlorite Sanitizer and Cleaner." Previously, Rhodia included the phrase "Available Chlorine 3.7% (nominal)" on the label. In EPA's stamped label dated Sep 25, 2003, EPA required the word "nominal" be deleted from the label. As providing the available chlorine content is not a requirement for this active ingredient, Rhodia would prefer to delete the entire phrase.


