

THIRAM 75 is a wettable powder formulation recommended for use as a seed treater, turf fungicide, and animal repellent.

**SEED TREATMENT:**

THIRAM 75, when used properly on crop seeds listed below will usually increase stands and yields by reducing losses from seed decay, damping off and seedling blight. Treat seed anytime after seeds are well cured.

\*Treat legume seed first, then inoculate just before planting if necessary.

ONIONS—(smut control) In set onions, use 10<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> oz. of THIRAM 75 to 10 lbs. of seed.

GLADIOLUS BULBS—For control of basal rot and corm decay—Dry bulbs thoroughly then coat them by shaking in paper bag or by dipping in a suspension of 1 lb THIRAM 75 in 8 gals. of water—if to be stored spread out to dry.

SWEET POTATOES—For control of scurf and stem rot of sweet potatoes, dip the roots of the sprouts for 1/2 minute into suspension of 1 lb. THIRAM 75 in 7 1/2 gals. of water, agitate frequently, plant sprouts shortly after treatment.

NOTE: LABEL TREATED SEED—"This seed treated with THIRAM 75. Do not use for feed food or oil purposes."

**TURF FUNGICIDE:**

To control Brown patch, dollar spot and snow mold, apply THIRAM 75 at the rate of 6 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. in sufficient water for good coverage. Apply at 10-day intervals during summer when conditions favor individual diseases. For information on timing, contact your local experiment station. Apply early before diseases appear. Do not use grass clippings for food or feed purposes. For snow mold control apply at the rate of 8 oz. per 1,000 sq. feet in late fall before snow falls and at the rate of 4 oz. per 1,000 sq. feet in the spring just after snow melts.

**ANIMAL REPELLENT:**

To protect forest trees, fruit trees, nursery stock, shrubs, and ornamentals for 6 months or longer (depending on weather and other conditions) from rabbits, meadow mice and deer, mix 1 lb. THIRAM 75 with 3 qts. water and 2 lbs. of a weather resistant sticker, such as Rohm & Haas Rhoplex AC-33. Do not mix more repellent than can be used in a short time. Apply during dormant or growing season before expected time of animal damage. It should be applied only when surface of plants to be treated are dry and under favorable drying conditions.

Mixed material may be applied as a:

SPRAY APPLICATION: Apply as a full coverage spray with a hand sprayer or mechanical sprayer. In the case of tree seedlings, it is suggested that not more than 3,000 seedlings be treated with each gallon of finished spray.

DIP APPLICATION: Apply to bundles of forest nursery or fruit tree planting stock by dipping to thoroughly wet the foliage and other parts to be protected. Excess repellent should be permitted to run off treated plants without coming in contact with the roots.

BUNDLES OF NURSERY PLANTING STOCK SHOULD BE PERMITTED TO DRY THOROUGHLY BEFORE PLANTING OR STORING.

BRUSH APPLICATION: Apply on lower trunk of fruit trees or ornamental plantings from ground level to a height of approximately 2 1/2 ft. to protect plants from injury to trunk.

Do not use on plant parts that are to be used for food or feed.
