Kryocide Insecticide  
EPA Registration No. 4581-116  
Your Labeling Submitted January 23, 1992

The Agency is conditionally approving an amendment to the registration of the above-referenced product under authority of section 3(c)(7)(B) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA). This amendment allows the use of the subject product on potatoes. In accordance with your request, this amendment will expire automatically on September 30, 1995. In addition, during the period that this amendment is effective, it will be subject to the conditions listed below. To maintain your registration, you must:

1. Place the following statement on the front panel of the label of each product bearing directions for use on potatoes.  
"Not for sale, distribution, or use on potatoes  
after September 30, 1995."

2. Submit the data required by the deadlines listed below, from studies conducted in accordance with the Good Laboratory Practice Registration Standards, 40 CFR Part 160, and appropriate test guidelines as referenced in EPA's Data Requirements for Registration regulation, 40 CFR Part 158. These deadlines reflect the current reregistration timeframes for the chemical cryolite.

a. Submit the information listed below, no later than  
June 30, 1993.

83-4 Rat Reproduction, 2- Generation

b. Submit the information listed below, no later than  
May 31, 1994.

83-1 Chronic Feeding, Non-Rodent

3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment bearing the subject amended labeling.

4. Submit/cite all data required for

registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

You should note that if you fail to satisfy any of the conditions imposed on this registration, i. e. you fail to submit the required data by the specified deadlines or the data submitted were not generated in accordance with the applicable test guidelines, EPA may issue a notice to cancel this amendment under section 6(e) of FIFRA.

You should also note that, regardless of whether you satisfy all applicable conditions, this conditional registration for use on potatoes will expire automatically on September 30, 1995. Sale and distribution of the subject product bearing labeling for use on potatoes after September 30, 1995, will be illegal. The tolerance authorizing residues of the subject product in potatoes will expire automatically on May 5, 1996.

Finally, once the itemized data under items 2a and 2b have been submitted, they will be reviewed. If the Agency finds that they are acceptable, EPA will consider an application to amend the registration of the subject product to allow use on potatoes without any special time restriction on the duration of the amendment should it receive such application.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Note that this acceptance of your label does not relieve you of your obligation to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS). If any of your products are covered by the WPS, you are required to submit, and receive the Agency's approval by April 21, 1994, of a revised label reflecting the required label statements of 40 CFR 156, published in the Federal Register on August 21, 1992 (57 FR 38102). Further guidance will be issued. According to 40 CFR 156, subpart K, specifically section 156.200 (c)(3): "No product to which this subpart applies shall be distributed or sold without amended labeling by any registrant after April 21, 1994."

Observe all applicable precautions, directions, and limitations on the EPA-registered label.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.
