Cotton Insect Control—For control of boll weevils, cotton aphids, cotton leafworms and spider miles, apply 1/2 pint to 1 pint per acre of Methyl Parathion 54 in sufficient amount of water for complete coverage depending upon type of equipment and size of cotton.

Methyl Parathion E-4 should be applied when first signs of insects appear and continued at 5 to 7 day intervals until Insects are under control. However, because local conditions and plant size largely determine the rate, frequency, and effectiveness of applications, it is recommended that Federal or State agricultural authorities be consulted for specific uses.

Do not apply within 5 days of hand picking. Workers entering fields within 24 hours of application should wear protective clothing.





Allow no further exposure until time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by blood tests.


