# ZIRAM W-76

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Ziram W-76 is effective against many fungus diseases. It has excellent translocation properties and is safe on a wide range of plants. It is compatible with DDT, Parathion, Malathion and many commonly used pesticides. Wash the required amount of Ziram W-76 through the filter screen while filling the sprayer with water, or make into a paste with water and pour into the sprayer tank while filling.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

In general use Ziram W-76 at 1 1/2 to 2 lbs. per 100 gallons of spray, unless otherwise stated. Three teaspoons per gallon of water is equivalent to 1 lb. per 100 gallons of water.

### APPLES (PACIFIC NORTHWEST) Apple scab—

Use 1 1/4 lbs. per 100 gallons in pre-blossom, calyx and early cover sprays. In Washington use 1 1/4 lbs. per 100 gallons of water in the first cover spray and in early September on delicious variety and late September on winesaps as a protectant spray only.

**Bull's Eye Rot**—Use 1 1/4 lbs. per 100 gallons in the first cover spray and in a pre-harvest spray before fall rains begin.

**PEARS (Oregon): Pear Scab**—Use at 1 1/2 lbs. per 100 gallons of water in early pink, pink, calyx and in first and second cover sprays as needed. **Bull's Eye Rot**—Use at 1 1/2 lbs. per 100 gallons of water in a pre-harvest spray if needed.

**PEACHES (Washington): Peach Leaf Curl**—Use 3 lbs. per 100 gallons of water in December. May be repeated in late winter before growth begins if needed.

**TOMATOES: Anthracnose and Early Blight**—Use 1 1/2 to 2 lbs. per 100 gallons of water when fruit or first clusters are formed and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals. Spraying at closer intervals may be necessary under weather conditions favoring the disease, starting when plants are set.

**BEANS: Rust, Anthracnose**—Use 1 1/2 to 2 lbs. per 100 gallons of water when disease first appears and repeat at 4 to 7 day intervals as long as the disease is a threat. Do not apply to snap beans later than 4 days before any picking.

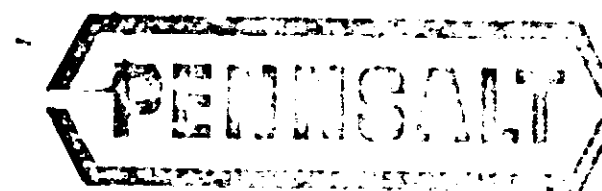
