GENERAL INFORMATION

THIRAM ANIMAL REPELLENT is a weather resistant contact repellent containing 20% Thiram. It is a specially formulated stable suspension designed for use on forest nursery planting stock, apple and peach

trees and ornamental plantings and nursery stock for protection against rabbits, meadow mice, and to a lesser extent, deer. It may be applied during the dormant or growing season. When applied as directed, a single application will protect treated surfaces of plants from rabbit, deer, and meadow mice damage up to six months or longer depending upon weather and other conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DILUTE THIRAM ANIMAL REPELLENT with equal parts water. A 1:1 dilution contains 10% Thiram. Mix thoroughly before applying and mix only the quantity to be used. Diluted material should be used immediately. The diluted repellent may be applied as a spray, dip or brush application.

SPRAY APPLICATION: Apply as a full coverage spray on forest nursery planting stock, ornamental plantings or other nursery stock. The spray can be applied with a hand sprayer or mechanical sprayer. Apply on forest nursery planting stock prior to planting. Apply to apple and peach

trees or ornamentals and other nursery stock in early fall or when rampant feeding damage is first noticed. In the case of tree seedlings, it is suggested that not more than 3000 seedlings be treated with each gallon of finished spray.

DIP AND DAB: Dip Apply to bundles of forest nursery or fruit tree planting stock by dipping to thoroughly wet the foliage and other parts to be protected. Excess repellent should be shaken off treated plants without coming in contact with the plants.

BUNDLES OF NURSERY PLANTING STOCK SHOULD BE PERMITTED TO DRY THOROUGHLY BEFORE PLANTING OR STORAGE.

BRUSH APPLICATION: Apply to forest nursery apple and peach trees.
