DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For use as a soil poison for termite control in areas adjacent to commercial and industrial buildings only where plant life is not desirable. Toxic to most forms of plant and animal life. For all applications, carefully pour two parts of concentrate into fifteen parts of water to make a solution containing 10 per cent sodium arsenite by weight. When used as a soil poison (in trenches), apply 2 gallons of diluted solution per 10 linear feet of trench up to 15 inches deep and 4 gallons per 10 linear feet for trenches over 15 inches deep. Pour half the specified quantity into the bottom of the trench and use the remaining half for treating the soil that is replaced into the trench. (Trenches may be dug up to 30 inches around buildings with deep foundations, but in no event should they be deeper than the top of the footings.)

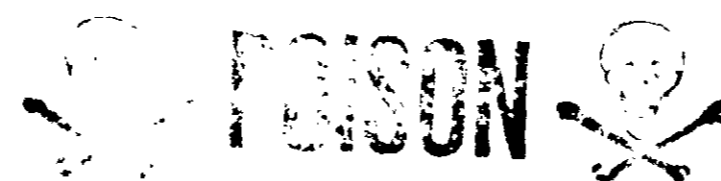
DISPOSITION OF EMPTY CONTAINERS

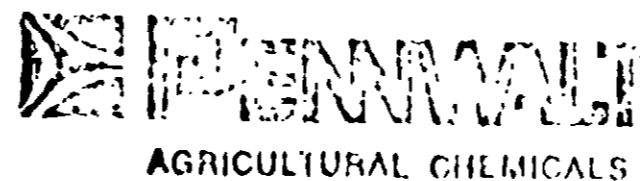

TAKEN INTERNALLY (SWALLOWED). Give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid clears. Then give two tablespoonfuls of Epsom salt or milk of magnesia in water and plenty of milk and water. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

INHALATION. If breathing is slow, apply artificial respiration.

SPILLED ON SKIN OR IN EYES. Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected skin areas with soap and water. If in eyes, immediately flush out with plenty of cool, clean water.
