GENERAL

TRICARBAMIX Fe is a special wettable powder formulation recommended for use on apples to correct minor element deficiencies. In addition, apple scab can be controlled.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR APPLES—Mix 3 pounds Tricarbamix Fe per 100 gallons of water. *APPLE SCAB*

Apply as a bulk spray early in the growing season (pink or early calyx stage). Follow by a second application in 10 to 14 days. Three applications may be necessary if deficiency symptoms are severe. If blotching occurs on the fruit, the use of a spreader-sticker such as X-77 is suggested to give uniform coverage. Do not use within 7 days of harvest on apples. Do not apply after first cover spray on Golden Delicious apples as a visible residue may result at harvest.

TRICARBAMIX Fe is compatible with most commonly used insecticides such as Parathion, Malathion, Perthane, Guthion. Do not mix with lime sulfur and oil as phytotoxicity may occur.

Bury or burn containers; never re-use. Stay out of smoke or fumes.
