GENERAL

Trimanzone is a spray base which may be used for the control of many fungus plant diseases. It mixes readily with water, suspends well, and adheres to sprayed surfaces with a minimum of run off.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use 1 1/2 to 2 pounds Trimanzone per acre in 100 to 125 gallons of water by ground application, or in 10 to 12 gallons of water by air application. Start filling the tank with water. Sift in the required amount of product when the agitator paddies are covered or the jet or recirculating pipe from pump is covered. Fill the tank when the product is thoroughly mixed.

CELERY: Early blight (Cercospora) and late blight (Septoria)—start applications in the plant bed and continue in the field as frequently as required (weekly under average conditions, every 3 to 5 days under severe conditions). Remove residues by stripping, trimming and washing.

TOMATOES: Late and early blights, Septoria leaf spot, gray leaf spot (Stemphylium), anthracnose—start applications when fruit of first clusters are well formed; repeat at 7 to 10-day intervals. When weather conditions favor late blight, more frequent applications may be necessary starting when plants are set in the fields.

CUCUMBERS, MELONS, SQUASH: Downy mildew and other leaf diseases (except powdery mildew), anthracnose—start treatment as soon as plants appear above ground or when disease threatens and continue at 7 to 10-day intervals as long as necessary. Under severe conditions, shorten interval to 3 to 5 days. For summer squash, do not apply later than 7 days before harvest.

BEANS (FIELD AND SNAP): Rust, anthracnose; **LIMA BEANS:** anthracnose, downy mildew—start applications when disease first appears and repeat at 4 to 7-day intervals as long as disease threatens. Do not apply to beans later than 7 days before any picking.

Do not feed treated plant parts to meat or dairy animals.

CARROTS: Leaf spot diseases—start application when disease threatens and continue at 7 to 10-day intervals as needed. Do not apply later than 7 days before harvest.

OTHER VEGETABLES: For plant bed use only—Downy mildew of broccoli, cabbage, and lettuce; anthracnose and Cercospora leaf spot of peppers—use 2 lbs. as a drenching spray starting when seed is planted and continue at 7 to 10-day intervals until transplanting.

COMPATIBILITY: This product is compatible with common insecticides, such as methoxychlor, DDT, organophosphorus compounds, arsenicals and rotenone.
