



DECCOSOL "P" CONCENTRATE

For control of organisms causing decay of apples and pears after harvest.

Active ingredient:

Sodium orthophenylphenate (anhydrous)23%

Inert ingredients77%

DIRECTIONS:

Recommended usage of Deccosol "P" Concentrate requires its dilution with water at the rate of one gallon Deccosol "P" Concentrate to between 72 and 90 gallons of water to make a treating solution of between 0.29% and 0.35% sodium orthophenylphenate. The apples and pears are exposed to this dilution for 1½ to 4 minutes after which they are thoroughly rinsed with fresh water. The orthophenylphenol residue resulting from the above treatment will be below the maximum tolerance of 25 ppm allowed by law. Or for use in the Decco Process by or under the supervision of the manufacturer's personnel.

DANGER:

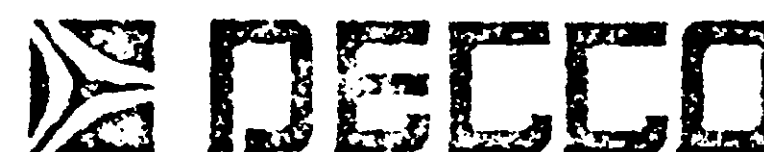

FIRST AID MEASURES: Eye contact—if the eyes are contaminated, they should be flushed with copious amounts of flowing water for at least 15 minutes. Medical attention should be obtained. Skin contact — contaminated clothing and shoes should be removed and not re-used until thoroughly cleaned. Wash contaminated skin with soap and plenty of water. Any injuries or irritations which may develop should receive medical attention.
