





For control of organisms causing decay of citrus after harvest.

٠ Active ingredient: Sodium orthophenylphenate (anhydrous) ..... 14.5% 

## DIRECTIONS:

To be used in citrus washing tanks at a concentration ranging from 2000 to 3500 ppm sodium orthophenylphenate. Caustic soda should be added, when necessary, to maintain pH in the washing tank above 11.6. The citrus should not be in the washing tank for more than 5 minutes and must be rinsed thoroughly with fresh water upon leaving tank. Or for use in the Decco Process by or under the supervision of the manufacturer's personnel.

## DANGER:



Skin contact - contaminated clothing and shoes should be removed and not re-used until thoroughly cleaned. Wash contaminated skin with soap and plenty of water. Any injuries or irritations which may develop should receive medical attention.
