

## DECCOSOL"NIF" CONCENTRATE

For control of organisms causing decay of citrus after harvest.

## **DIRECTIONS:**

For use in mechanical foamers. Dilute one gallon of concentrate with 9 gallons of water. Contact time with citrus should be between 10 and 30 seconds. Follow treatment with adequate fresh water sprays. When used according to directions, residues of orthophenylphenol on citrus will be below 10 ppm allowed by law. Or for use in the Decco Process by or under the supervision of the manufacturer's personnel.

## **DANGER:**

**KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.** Harmful if swallowed. May cause burns or damage to the eyes. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Handling precautions for cleaning up spills or when gross contact is likely. Eyes — safety glasses with sideshields. Skin — avoid skin contact. Wear protective clothing as required by circumstances to prevent skin contact.

FIRST AID MEASURES: Eye contact—if the eyes are contaminated, they should be flushed with copious amounts of flowing water for at least 15 minutes. Medical attention should be obtained. Skin contact—contaminated clothing and shoes should be removed and not re-used until thoroughly cleaned. Wash contaminated skin with soap and plenty of water. Any injuries or irritations which may develop should receive medical attention.
