The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section (3) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable provided that you make the following changes:

Ingredient Statement:

- Line up the percentages of mancozeb, "Inert Ingredients" and the total concentration so that all three fall along the same vertical line.
- Change the "100%" in the "Total" row to "100.0%" and line it up so that its decimal point lies in a vertical line under the decimal points for "88.0%" and "12.0%".

Precautionary Statements:

Change "May cause moderate eye irritation." to "Causes moderate eye irritation."

Directions for Use:

In the last sentence change "Manufacturer disclaims liability for claims or damages resulting from ..." to "Manufacturer disclaims liability for claims or damages resulting from ..."

Storage and Disposal:

Change the heading "Storage Instructions" to "Pesticide Storage Instructions".

Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
