

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

Fatal if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe dust, vapor, or spray mist. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.
