Your label amendment submitted May 20, 2002 to add pears as a new use.

The supplemental label for pears, referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable provided the following conditions are met:

1. Submit the following study, which is required to support the use of thiophanate methyl on pears: OPPTS 875.2100 Foliar Dislodgeable Residue Dissipation for pears, due by November 2004
2. Revise the label as follows:
a. Add the phrase "Supplemental Label", at the top of the page.
b. Add the following text immediately above the sentence beginning "Observe all applicable precautions .."
For crops without labeled uses of thiophanate-methyl, observe a 30-day plantback restriction.
3. In accordance with section 408 (b) (2) (E) (ii) of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA), because anticipated or actual residue levels are being relied on for apples, bananas, beans, cucurbits, peaches and strawberries, the Agency is requiring, pursuant to subsection (f) (1), that you provide, five years after the date on which the tolerance is established, modified, or left in effect, and thereafter as the Administrator deems appropriate, data demonstrating that such residue levels are not above the levels so relied on. If such data are not so provided, or if the data do not demonstrate that the residue levels are not above the levels so relied on, the Administrator shall, no later than 180 days after the date on which the data were required to be provided, issue a regulation under subsection (e) (1), or an order under subsection (f) (2), as appropriate, to modify or revoke the tolerance.
4. This label change must be incorporated into your main label at the next printing or by February 1, 2004, whichever comes first.
5. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
