In the interim, the Agency is accepting the signal word and modified "Precautionary Statements" supporting category III language based on primary eye irritation because we believe the new study will confirm toxicity category III classification.
- 2. If the study is found unacceptable, you must submit a revised label supporting toxicity category II signal word and precautionary statements thirty (30) days from the Agency letter notifying you the status of the study.
