MOTH BLOCK

For Closets

Kills Clothes Moths — Deodorizes — Aids in Mildew Control

HOW TO USE: Remove cellophame and place Block high in area desired.
TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS: Place moth house articles before storing.
Use at the rate of one Block every 17 cubic feet of tightly enclosed space.
Keep closet tightly closed at all times, even for at least 7 days after
addition of the chemical. If closet is to be opened, occasionally,
additional chemical should be added and the closet should remain
closed for at least 7 days.

TO AID IN CONTROL OF MILDREW: Use 1 deodorant Block to
every 17 cubic feet of tightly enclosed space. Clothes should
be cleaned prior to treatment. Closet should be kept closed
for at least 7 days after addition of product. Additional
chemical should be added when closet is reopened.
Note: Do not place Block in contact with plastic materials.
