DIRECTIONS

is highly penetrative, and may be applied with spray or brush in two or more flowing coats. Fence posts and other heavy timbers should be free of bark, dry and well seasoned, and should be treated by the dip method for at least 48 hours. Frequent inspections and retreatment may be necessary to maintain protection from fungal decay.
