GENERAL CLEANING

TO CLEAN, bleach and deodorize wooden or tile drainboards, refrigerators, kitchen sinks, enamelware, wooden utensils, woodwork, linoleum, bathtubs, chinaware, washbowls, tile floors, etc., use three tablespoons of COTTAGE BLEACH to each quart of warm water. Wash the surface and allow solution to remain a few minutes; then rinse well in clear water.

DISINFECTING

Wash all articles or surface thoroughly with warm suds; apply solution 3 tablespoons of COTTAGE BLEACH to each quart warm water; let stand 5 minutes—rinse, then dry.

SICKROOM—Bedpans, Sputum Cups, Rubber Sheets, etc.—Wash thoroughly; rinse well with solution of 3 tablespoons COTTAGE BLEACH to each quart warm water; let stand 5 minutes—rinse, then dry.

REMOVING STAINS

REMOVING STAINS—To remove stains such as ink, berry, coffee, mildew, or scorch from white cotton or linen, soak articles a few minutes in a solution one part COTTAGE BLEACH to twenty parts water. Repeat if necessary. Rinse well.

ODORS—Vegetable odors such as garlic, onions, cabbage, can be destroyed by using COTTAGE BLEACH.

CAUTION

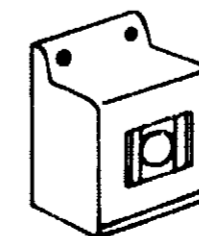
DISHES

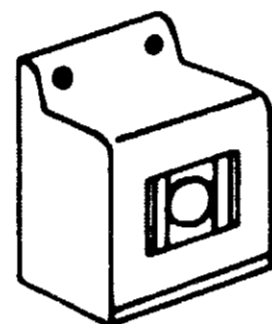
DISHES

WASHING MACHINE—Use 1/2 teacup COTTAGE BLEACH to washer of warm water.

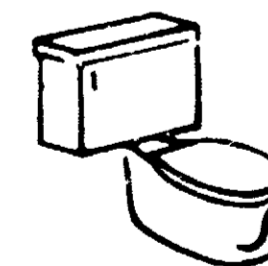
SWIMMING POOL

Use 5 cups ~~COTTAGE~~ BLEACH to 10,000 gallons of water, add more as needed to maintain a residual of 0.6-1.0 ppm available chlorine as determined by test kit at all times.



TOILET BOWLS

TOILET BOWLS—Pour 1/2 cup COTTAGE BLEACH into bowl. Swish solution over all inside surfaces. Add three tablespoonfuls vinegar. Let stand one hour. Rinse well.



RE-USE THIS STRONG DURABLE CONTAINER

- A funnel by cutting off below the handle.
- A flower pot or paint can by cutting off the top.
- A water-tight float or a water storage jug.
- A sand scoop by cutting off the bottom.
