Open Recirculating Ceeling Systems: Initial Dase: When microbiological slimes are evident, apply 9.3 to 18.6 fl azs of DEARCIDE 717 per 1000 gals (75 ppm to 150 ppm) of water in the system. Repeat until control is achieved. Badly fauled systems should be cleaned before treatment is begun.

Subsequent Dose: When microbiological control is evident, apply 6.2 to 12.4 fl azs of DEARCIDE 717 per 1000 gals (50 ppm to 100 ppm) of water in the system once per week or as needed to maintain control.

This product should be fed as early as possible in the system of such points including the hydropulper, machine chast or broke system.
