DIRECTIONS FOR USE: INITIAL DOSE: WHEN MICROBIOLOGICAL SLIMES ARE EVIDENT, APPLY 13.2 TO 26.4 FLUID OUNCES OF DEARCIDE[®] 705 PER 1000 GALLONS (100 TO 200 PPM OF PRODUCT) OF WATER IN THE SYSTEM. REPEAT UNTIL CONTROL IS ACHIEVED. BADLY FOULED SYSTEMS SHOULD BE CLEANED BEFORE TREATMENT IS BEGUN. SUBSEQUENT DOSE: WHEN MICROBIOLOGICAL CONTROL IS EVIDENT, APPLY 13.2 TO 26.4 FLUID OUNCES OF DEARCIDE[®] 705 PER 1000 GALLONS (100 TO 150 PPM OF PRODUCT) OF WATER IN THE SYSTEM ONCE PER WEEK, OR AS NEEDED TO MAINTAIN CONTROL.
