STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. If plastic, do not reuse empty container. PAPER MILLS: For the control of bacterial and fungal slime in the production of paper. PAPER TEK 6202 should be added to a point in the system to insure uniform mixing such as the Beater, Hydropulper or fan on broke storage pumps.

DOSAGE: Apply 0.22 to 0.75 lbs (3.5 to 11.5 fl. oz.) of PAPER TEK 6202 per ton (dry basis) of pulp or paper produced as a slug dose. If needed, repeat daily. Badly fouled systems should be cleaned before initial treatment.

PAPER-TEK 6202 is authorized for use as a slimeicide in the manufacture of paper and paper board that contacts food, at the approved dosage level provided above per 21CFR 176.300(c).
