STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. **PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate with water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Keep away from heat and flame. Do not reuse container.
2. **STORAGE:** Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not store near food or feedstuffs. Containers should be stored at room temperature in a dry, well ventilated area. Store away from flammable materials, source of heat and flame, and foodstuffs. Exercise due caution to prevent damage to leakage from the container. Avoid prolonged storage at temperatures above 158°F/70°C.
3. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Water resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
4. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:**
METAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture. Puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH THE LABELING

PAPER MILLS: For the control of bacterial and fungal slime in the production of paper. PAPER-TEK 748 should be added to a point in the system to insure uniform mixing such as the Beater, Hydropulper or fan on Broke Storage Pumps.

DOSAGE: 5 to 20 ppm of PAPER-TEK 748 per ton (dry basis) of pulp or paper produced as a slug dose. If needed, repeat daily. Badly fouled systems should be cleaned before initial treatment.

PAPER-TEK 748 is authorized for use as a slimicide in the manufacture of paper and paper board that contacts food, at the approved dosage level provided above per 21 CFR 176.300(c).

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID

Immediately start the procedures given below and CONTACT A POISON CENTER, A PHYSICIAN OR THE NEAREST HOSPITAL. Describe the type and extent or exposure, the victim's symptoms, and follow the advice given.

If swallowed, immediately give several glasses of water but do not induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs, give fluids again. Have a physician determine if condition will permit induction of vomiting or evacuation of stomach. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes and skin with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. For eyes, hold eyelids apart during the flushing to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eye and lids with water. Get medical attention immediately. If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, oxygen may be given with a physician's advice using a demand-type or a continuous-flow inhaler. If not breathing, clear victim's airway, start mouth-to-mouth artificial respiration. Get medical attention.
