The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The condition disposal directions appearing on your submitted label are for non-pressurized liquid in metal containers. The advice presented conflicts with the prohibition against incinerating containers because of the hazard of bursting. Please revise this container disposal section to read: "Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
