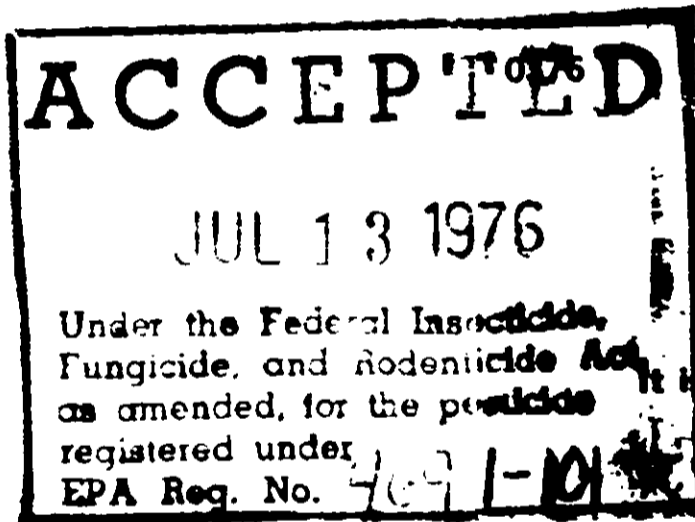
SCREW WORM AND BLOWFLY INFESTATIONS:
Apply with a swab or brush, working into deep pockets. Also spread smear around and over drainage area below wound. Repeat applications at 5- to 7-day intervals until wound is healed. Freely bleeding wounds may require several applications.

TO PREVENT SCREW WORM AND BLOWFLY INFESTATIONS:
Apply directly to all open or fresh wounds resulting from dehorning, castration, shear cuts, etc. Also treat navels of newborn animals. Freely bleeding wounds may require several applications. Repeat applications at 5- to 7-day intervals until wound is healed.
