PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If On Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water.

Role to Population: Product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine sulfate by injection is antidoted only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibitor appear.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Remove tags before slaughter. Keep container sealed when not in use.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Attach one tag per animal in the spring for control of horn flies and as an aid to the control of horn flies which are suspected of becoming resistant to pyrethroids for full summer season. Tags are easy to apply or replace if necessary. Attach two tags per animal to control face flies, gulf coast ticks, spinhosus ear ticks and as an aid in the control of lice, stable flies, and horseflies. EAR FORCE RANGER TAGS are easy to attach using a variety of methods. They may be punched through an existing ear tag using the ALLPLEX tagging system. See diagram on reverse. However, tags punched through adult cow identification tags on young calves may result in tearing the ear and loss of the tags. Tags may also be positioned across shoulders where animals are forced to pass them so they gain access to barns, feeders, waters or milking areas. Calves and cows may mutilate tags by chewing and chewing.

METHOD OF APPLICATION



STEP 1
Push ear tag under ear by compressing sides. Center ear tag itself by pushing up sides from bottom on pin. Align slot with hole in tag. Tag and button are now ready for insertion.



When properly inserted the tag should hang in place.



STEP 2
Put ear tag on the flat surface of center of ear. Do not allow shift of the skin button to dislodge any markings off or break vessel.
