Dear Ms. Bishop:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

1. Under the FIRST AID section, add the following statements:

"IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a poison control center for treatment advice.
2. Under the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section of your label, add the following statement: "Harmful if inhaled."
3. Under "Horses" and "Horses and Foals", either delete the statements "Repeat as needed" or "Repeat treatment as needed" or indicate a time period for retreatment based on the residual efficacy of your product.
