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




**Figure 1.**  
 Place female tag under clip by depressing lever. Collar on tag must be pointing down.



**Figure 2.**  
 Slide male button on pin until it projects through top tag and button are now ready for application. Distinct pliers and tags prior to application.



**Figure 3.**  
 Position tag on the ear surface in center of ear. Do not allow shaft of the male button to penetrate any cartilage or blood vessel. Ear damage may result.



**Figure 4.**  
 When properly positioned, the tag should hang as shown.

For optimum pest control, attach one tag to each ear when pests first appear. Tags may remain effective for up to 5-6 months (susceptible horn flies). Replace as necessary. Apply with the Allflex® Tagging System.


