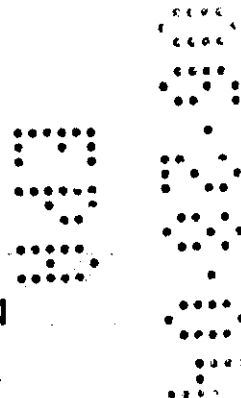

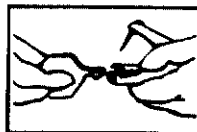

Place female tag under clip by depressing lever. Collar on tag must be pointing down.

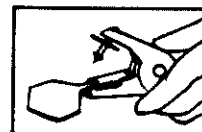

Slide male button on pin. Align tip of male button with female portion of tag. Tag and button are now ready for application.

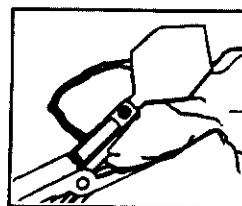

Position tag on the flat surface in center of ear. Do not allow shaft of the male button to penetrate any cartilage rib or blood vessel. Ear damage may result.

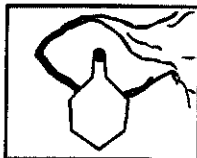

When properly positioned, the tag should hang as shown.

For optimum pest control, attach one tag to each ear when pests first appear. Tags may remain effective for up to 5-6 months (susceptible horn flies). Replace as necessary. Apply with the Allflex® Tagging System.

Please find enclosed a copy of the subject label with changes marked in red. In addition, I have enclosed two copies of the new label with changes completed. BIVI has changed from open tip rivets to closed tip rivets. In addition, BIVI no longer requires customers to disinfect pliers and tags prior to application. With the use of a closed tip rivet, only the rivet pierces through the cattle's ears, not the applicator tool.
